6.	Sileni Cellar Selection, Sauvignon Blanc 12.5%, Marlborough NZ The Cellar Selection Sauvignon Blanc has ripe tropical and gooseberry fruit flavours with a zingy finish and impeccable balance. 1.	Pasqua Letters, Montepulciano 12.5%, Italy This is a characterful red wine with gentle tannins, excellent structure and a bright intense colour. It offers sensations of ripe red fruits as well as spicy hints.	£3.30	£4.35	£6.55	£13	£18
2.	Los Espinos, Merlot (Vegan) 12%, Chile Purple-red wine of medium intensity. On the nose there are aromas of sweet blueberries, blackberries and blackcurrant notes. On the palate it feels fresh, mature and elegant with a medium and delicate structure. 3.	Botter, Primitivo Salento, Doppio (Vegan) 13%, Italy Medium bodied, rounded, warm and silky with juicy red plums, red cherries and soft tannins.	£4.15	£5.05	£6.75	£14.50	£20

5.	Bon Courage, Shiraz, Pepper Pot (Vegan) 15%, South Africa The bouquet of this wine suggests tremendously ripe fruit, reminiscent of spicy plum jam. Ripe, sweet-fruited nose with loads of berry fruit, pepper and vanilla with subtle hints of karoo boss. Smoke and spice develop as the glass stands. 1. Volandas Rosé Cabernet 13.5%, (Vegetarian) Chile Bright pink colour with subtle aromatics of rosehip, cranberry, white pepper, bramble, hedgerows and redcurrant.	£3.50	£4.40	£6.50	£13	£18.50
2. Adobe Reserva Rosé, Organic (Vegan) 12% Chile Pretty and pink and full of delight! Bright light pink in colour with intense fruity aromas, such as cherry and black currant. Good body, silky and elegant on the palate. Tremendously fresh, fruity, and balanced. Delicate and easy to drink	£4.50	£6	£8	£17	£23
3. Mirabeau Pure Cotes De Provence 12.5%, Provance, France Fashioned from grapes grown in some of the highest vineyards in the Côtes de Provence. Grenache is blended with the punchier Syrah with its ripe cherry and raspberry flavours, a smattering of Vermentino provides delicacy and a hint of white pepper. Provençal, herbaceous 'garrigue' flavours meld well with hints of grapefruit, cherry and orange blossom on a palate which finishes on a refreshing mineral note.	£8	£9.50	£13	£27	£36

1. Prosecco Brut, Famiglia Pasqua (Vegetarian) 10.5% Italy Lively and well-balanced with subtle aromatics of grilled hazelnuts, crisp green apples and melon.	£6	£25
2. Sparkling Rosé, Romeo & Juliet (Vegetarian) 11% Italy Pale salmon in colour, fresh on the nose with notes of pear and red fruits. On the palate is dry with hints of red fruits and refreshing acidity. Delicate and elegant with persistent perlage.	£6	£26
3. Champagne, Jules Feraud 12.5% France Fresh and extremely appealing with notes of caramel, buttered toast, grilled nuts and pistachio shells.	£9	£36
4. Chapel Down, Bacchus 12% Kent, England Chapel Down Sparkling Bacchus 2018 is characterised by aromas of pineapple, grapefruit and elderflower. The palate is tropical and floral with a crisp texture and a refreshing finish.	£8	£35
